## EDUCATION FOR CHILDREN

## The Urgent need for Education for sustainable development and Wildlife Protection & Conservation

- In the area where our educational initiative operates (the Greater Kruger National Park, KNP), local children navigate a complex and often challenging family backdrop.
- They are part of a community just a few kilometers from South Africa's largest national park, surrounded by unique biodiversity.
- Yet, due to poverty and a troubled history, they are completely cut off from their natural heritage.
- Children growing up so close to such an impressive wildlife haven have no clue about these creatures, nor are they aware of their existence or the need to protect their national heritage.
- The impacts of poverty and lack of education have negatively affected the connection between the children and their environment, the animals, and species conservation.
- These children have no chance to grasp the significance of sustainability, ecological responsibility, and the protection of endangered species.



- Children from these towns and villages are easily recruited as young adults to engage in poaching and wildlife crime.
- Our mission now, through our sustainable educational initiative, is to equip these children with the resources to reconnect with their environment and the animals.
- We aim to heighten their awareness of the unique biodiversity in their immediate surroundings and provide them with the opportunity to actively contribute to species conservation.
- However, we need support for this. Our biggest challenge lies in engaging the local community, especially the children as the upcoming generation, in this vital task.
- Because without education and access to basic resources, any conservation initiatives will fall flat. It is vital for us to ensure that the children receive a high-quality education and have the chance to unfold their potentials.
- Koru Camp achieves this by giving the children access to daily meals, which they
  often go without, classroom participation in life skills, and active wilderness
  adventures to see and engage with wildlife around them.



## KORU CAMP

#### **Koru Camp for Sustainable Educational Initiative**

- Rhino Revolution strategically makes use of Koru Camp to address various challenges in its educational mission.
- Koru Camp is a non-profit camp nestled in the Greater Kruger area. Their mission is to connect local, disadvantaged communities with their natural heritage and help establish a love for the environment.
- Situated within a 'Big 5 Reserve,' our programme accommodates 12 children and a teacher.
- This intentional decision is driven by our emphasis of ensuring high-quality and closely-knit care for the children. Maintaining a smaller group size allows us to better attend to the individual needs and well-being of each child in our care.
- It is supervised by Rhino Revolution (RR) staff and features tents for accommodation, a central area for lessons and meals, healthy catering, and basic bathroom facilities.
- An electric fence surrounding the property ensures security.
- Koru Camp stands out as a flagship project for sustainable educational initiatives.
- Children have the opportunity to go on Safari game drives up to twice a day, gaining insights into conservation and biodiversity.
- Additionally, during the midday heat, the children receive lessons from Rhino Revolution in the open aired, "Eco Classroom".
- All meals are provided by RR during the children's camp to ensure they are well fed. For many, this is the first time, some children will have 3 meals a day.























## **GOALS OF THE INITIATIVE**

## Education on Biodiversity and Environmental Conservation

Koru Camp provides kids with a unique chance to learn about environmental and nature topics right in the midst of the wilderness.

Our dedicated staff not only imparts knowledge but also nurtures essential skills such as reading and writing in English, along with teamwork.

The lessons at the heart of the camp offer the children an inspiring and immersive learning experience.







## **Incentives for Academic Achievements**

We incentivise and inspire our learners that form part of Rhino Revolution's educational initiative through special outings to acknowledge their academic accomplishments.

These incentives are granted for excellent reading performances, excelling in competitions, outstanding grades, aiming to further motivate all learners in the class and demonstrate that dedication, learning, and hard work are rewarded in life.

However, the camping trip is something truly extraordinary for the children.

For about 80% of the learners, it will be the first time experiencing the fascinating wildlife of Africa.

Our educational initiative provides these children with a rare chance to acquire valuable skills and experiences they wouldn't otherwise have.

## Gateway to Conservation Careers

In the region bordering the Kruger National Park, numerous job opportunities unfold in the realms of conservation and tourism within the lodges.

Children encounter early exposure to conservation, acquiring essential building blocks of knowledge. These early experiences lay crucial foundations for future careers & cherished jobs, providing interested children with the chance to set their course toward meaningful professional paths.





## Access to the Fascinating Wildlife of Africa

We provide game drives on Safari which provides kids with the thrilling opportunity to explore the world of animals together with a local guide who speaks their mother tongue, Tsonga and English.

In doing so, they learn not only about the captivating animals but also about the diverse plant life and the delicate ecosystem.

At the same time, they have the chance to make unique animal observations and gather unforgettable memories in nature.






















## EMPOWERING ACORNHOEK

## Why does Rhino Revolution choose to educate children of Acornhoek?

- Rhino Revolution (RR) operates in South Africa, just 35 km from Acornhoek; a rural community in the Mpumalanga province of South Africa.
- The region grapples with various challenges that hits hard on unemployment, social problems, and as a result a leaning towards wildlife and other crime.
- We work, right on the edge of the Kruger National Park (KNP); home to both white and black rhino and a broad spectrum of wildlife.
- Given our holistic approach to environmental and species conservation, it makes sense to focus our educational initiative in Acornhoek, where it has been seen that much wildlife crime originates.





# THE CURRENT SITUATION

#### **Challenges for the People of Acornhoek**

- Unemployment: Acornhoek's feeling the pinch of high unemployment. The main culprits are the lack of ample job opportunities in the region and a shortage of skilled workers. Many folks are forced to hustle in informal sectors or commute to nearby cities to find work.
- Social problems: The rampant unemployment triggers a slew of social & leaning to crime issues in Acornhoek.
- Poverty, inadequate housing, limited access to education, and healthcare are widespread.
- Particularly, the poorer population struggles to meet basic needs, potentially leading to a lack of social mobility.
- Crime: Like in many underprivileged communities, crime rates are on the rise in Acornhoek. The factors mentioned, along with limited resources, contribute to an uptick in thefts, robberies, and violent crime and a leaning to easy Wildlife Crime.
- Education: In Acornhoek, the education institutions are grappling with challenges such as limited resources, overcrowding, and a shortage of qualified educators. This results in a very low standard if any of education.
- Healthcare: Access to high-quality healthcare is restricted in Acornhoek. There is a high prevalence of infectious diseases such as HIV/AIDS and tuberculosis. The lack of medical personnel and infrastructure complicates the addressing of these health issues.







- In addition to regional issues, Acornhoek also bears the historical burden of apartheid, impacting the community.
- One of the challenges is that rural black communities often lack sufficient access to wilderness and wildlife.

MANY INDIVIDUALS NEVER GET THE OPPORTUNITY TO WITNESS OR ENGAGE WITH AFRICA'S INCREDIBLE WILDLIFE, WHICH IS THEIR NATIONAL HERITAGE, CREATING A DISCONNECT FROM THE ENVIRONMENT AND NATURE.

- This lack of access to wildlife can be traced back to the spatial separation during apartheid when certain areas were reserved for white population groups, excluding black communities. This resulted in a gap between people and the natural environment that persists to this day.
- Another issue negatively affecting the environment and nature in Acornhoek is the widespread practice of uncontrolled waste disposal.
- In some cases, there is inadequate infrastructure for waste management, and there is limited awareness of environmental conservation and waste management. This leads to litter being casually discarded and accumulating in the surroundings.
- It is crucial to acknowledge these issues and take measures to improve access to wildlife, promote environmental awareness, and implement better waste disposal systems.
- Through educational initiatives, community-based programs, and enhanced collaboration with the local communities, progress can be made to restore the connection between the people in Acornhoek and nature, fostering a more sustainable future.











## FINANCIAL BLUEPRINT

At a Glance: The Investment

The cost plan encompasses the investment for an excursion to Koru Camp (four days and three nights) with 12 children, one teacher, and two staff members from Rhino Revolution. In the year 2025, a total of 20 Koru Camp trips are planned. To finance these, we require donations totaling \$50,000. This will provide the opportunity for a total of 240 children from a rural community in our educational initiative to participate in this sustainable educational experience.

## FINANCIAL BLUEPRINT

At a Glance: The Investment

#### **ACCOMMODATION EXPENSES:**

Rhino Revolution is invoiced by the non-profit organization Koru Camp for the costs of accommodation, meals, and safari as per the details mentioned above. To conduct the camp, it is necessary for a school supervisor to accompany the camp. The teaching sessions are led by two staff members from Rhino Revolution to ensure a high-quality educational experience.

#### PROPORTIONATE STAFF EXPENSES:

Ensuring the successful implementation of this educational initiative, overseen by two dedicated staff members, involves allocating one day for preparation and one day for debriefing. In addition, three days are reserved for the camp itself. Administrative tasks essential for planning have also been factored into the schedule.

#### T-SHIRTS UND KAPPEN:

We require T-shirts and caps for the children in our educational initiative to enhance team spirit and ensure that no child is excluded due to their social or financial circumstances. Uniform clothing establishes a shared identity, fostering a sense of belonging within the group.

#### TRANSPORTATION EXPENSES:

We utilize our minibus to pick up children from school and transport them to the reserve's entrance. After their stay at the camp, they are safely returned to school. The transportation costs cover the round-trip, ensuring that all children can participate comfortably and safely in the program.

#### PROPORTIONATE OFFICE EXPENSES:

During the planning and organization of this educational initiative, the team operates from its dedicated workspace. The associated administrative costs have been proportionately allocated to the educational measure, as they are essential for the realization of the project.

#### **EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS:**

For each Koru Camp, the team creates specialized teaching materials. The associated printing or acquisition costs are covered by this lump sum, enabling Rhino Revolution to address group-specific needs.
